Inside a Post Office

Many things keep happening to us in our life. We want to talk of them to others. But sometimes these persons might be living far away from us. Then we wish to send our messages to them in writing or in some other way. Here we are giving some common means of sending messages :

Post Office: We can send our messages through post office. People buy **postcards**, inland letters, envelopes and postage stamps from a post office. All these are used to send messages by post. These postal messages are sent to their destination by road, rail or air. Then a postman delivers them from door to door. It costs very little to send messages through post. **We can send parcels** by post. **We can also send money** through what is called a **money order**.

Courier: Courier companies also deliver posts and parcels to people. They charge very little for their services.

Telephone: Letters and SMS, e-mails etc. are means of communication. They can't get us the other person's reply instantly. For an instant reply, we can use a telephone. It is the easiest and the quickest means of communication. We can talk to our friends and relatives living far away from us over a telephone. We can even talk to people living in foreign countries. These days even villages have telephone connections. Mobile phones have made it possible to make a phone call even while travelling.

Do You Know: Telegram was the earliest form of modern telecommunications. It was used to send messages over wires by the use of electrical pulses. These days email, sms, social networking sites, internet, etc., have come into vogue. Thus, telegram has become obsolete after 164 years of service. It has been replaced by quicker and smarter devices like smartphones.

Means of Mass Communication :

Letters, sms, e-mails and mobile phones are used for sending messages to individuals. But when we want to convey a message to large numbers of people, we can't do it through these means. Then we have to use some means of mass communication. The newspaper, the radio and the television are means of mass communication.

Newspapers bring us news from all parts of the world. They also give us information on many different subjects. **Newspapers don't cost much.** By spending a little amount, we can keep ourselves informed about the latest happenings in the world.



Some Common Means of Communication.

The **Radio** is another means of mass communication. It gives us latest news and lot of useful information. It also provides entertainment through songs, music, drama, commentary, etc.

The **Television** is still a better means of mass communication. It has all the advantages of the radio. Besides, it shows us pictures. Not only we can hear but also see what is happening at a particular time or a particular place. The television is, therefore, the most useful means of mass communication. We can see films and many other entertainment programmes on the TV. We can also learn much through different educational programmes. In fact, the TV is the most popular means of communication, education and entertainment. It also helps us to know, about the life of people living in different parts of the country and the world. **Computer (IT)** is another important means of mass communication.
