Expected Learning Outcome:	<p>The students will have understood the topic and should be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * comprehend, deduce and infer from a text * identify the figures of speech of comparison * write effectively and thus create a better image in the readers' mind * differentiate a word being used as a noun or as a verb * listen, recall, deduce and infer * understand and appreciate prose as a literary form * understand the theme of the story * critically examine one's blind faith in God * justify the theme 'Humanity still exists'
Methodology:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Click on the following link https://www.edufever.com/class-10-english-ncert-books/ and download the lesson 'A Letter to God'. 2. Study the 'money order' form in the lesson and complete the activity based on it. You may also ask your parents or grandparents to explain the money order form and the process. 3. Read the lesson and answer the oral comprehension questions. Please note the meanings of the words given on the right hand side. 4. Write the answers of the questions in 'Thinking about the text' in a notebook. 5. Open the Diksha App (on the phone) and click on English Medium ,Click on class 10, Click on English and then on First Flight and 'A Letter to God'. Watch the video and after watching the video click on the Question Bank and read all the questions and solutions.

Read 'Thinking about language' and attempt Q. 8 (I and II). Understand words that are used as a 'verb' as well as a 'noun'. For deeper understanding refer to https://www.k12reader.com/101-nouns-that-are-also-verbs/</p> <p>7. Click on https://youtu.be/8dT_MIEIHo8 and listen to 'clauses' and then click on https://youtu.be/Pr0qHd1KEMY to understand 'relative clauses'. Attempt Q.III in the text.</p> <p>8. Read Q. IV (using negatives for emphasis) and attempt the exercise.</p> <p>9. Watch a video on https://youtu.be/D3a-Dzx9yts to understand 'metaphors'. Copy and complete the table in Q. V on page 11.</p> <p><u>Note- all the exercises should be done in a notebook.</u></p>
