<b>Methodology:</b>	<p><b>1.</b>Click on the following link  <a href="https://www.edufever.com/class-10-english-ncert-books/">https://www.edufever.com/class-10-english-ncert-books/</a>  Scroll down to <b>Class 10 English First Flight and Footprints without Feet NCERT Book</b> and click on the lesson ‘The Thief’s Story’ and download it.</p> <p><b>2.</b> Read the lesson. You may refer to the meanings of words at the end of the lesson.</p> <p><b>3.</b> Write the answers of the six questions in ‘Read and Find Out’ (three questions on page 8 and three on page10) of the text book. Number these questions from 1 to 6 and write them on any paper / notebook.</p> <p><b>4.</b> Open the Diksha App (on the phone) and click on English Medium, Click on class 10, Click on English and then on ‘Footprints without Feet’ and ‘The Thief’s Story’. After that scroll down and click on the Question Bank and read all the questions and solutions in the following categories - Long Answer, Multiple Choice Question, Short Answer and Very Short Answer.</p>

	<p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p>Open Google on your computer and go to <a href="https://diksha.gov.in/">https://diksha.gov.in/</a> and click on 'Explore Content' and follow the process stated above. Read the short answer and long answer.</p>
<b>Activity:</b>	<p>Click on <a href="http://www.eastoftheweb.com/short-stories/UBooks/ScanBohe.shtml">http://www.eastoftheweb.com/short-stories/UBooks/ScanBohe.shtml</a> and read the story 'A Scandal in Bohemia' by Arthur Conan Doyle (the great story writer who created the famous character, Sherlock Holmes).</p>
<b>Evaluation:</b>	<p><b>Multiple Assessment Activity ( MANDATORY)</b> Write a paragraph (in not more than 100 words) on 'Love is a powerful force that can transform a criminal into a responsible citizen'.</p> <p>Write on any foolscap sheet / paper. Write the title as Multiple Assessment and write your name, class and section.</p>
