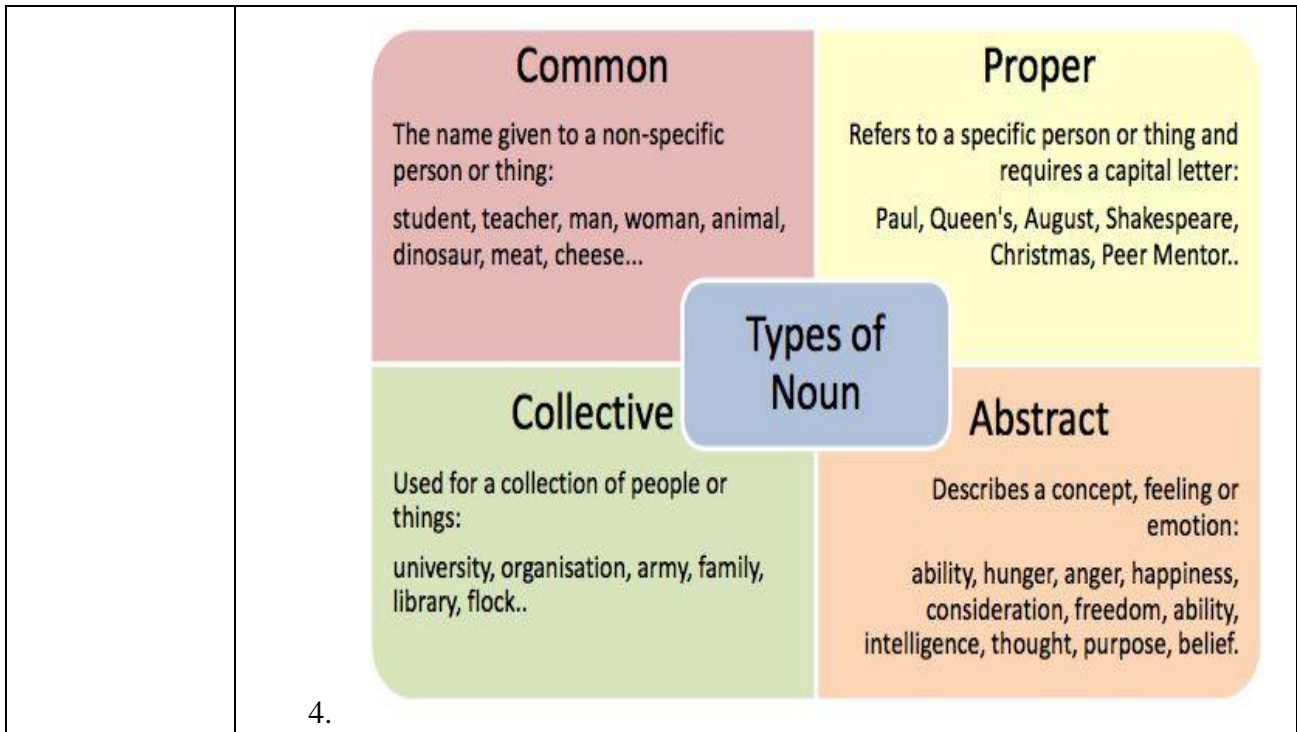

<b>Content</b>	<p>Introduction:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. <b>KINDS OF NOUNS:</b> Nouns are one of the most important part of grammar. A Noun is a part of speech that names a person, place, thing, idea, action or quality. It is a <b>NAMING WORD</b>.</li><li>2. Nouns can be either <u>singular</u> or <u>plural</u>.
